APPENDIX A – SCHOOL CAPTAIN ROLE DESCRIPTION

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Have attended NPSS at least for last 2 years with a good attendance record
- An excellent punctuality
- Good academic performance in the class (speaking, reading & writing skills in Sinhala within the context of Sinhala as a second language) and participation in extra-curricular activities such as assembly performance, BMR, New Year events etc.
- Positive attitude towards their duties/responsibilities
- Ability to perform their duties/responsibilities with enthusiasm
- Two students (preferably a girl & a boy) be selected for duration of 2 school terms

GENERAL RESPONSABILITIES

- To be an excellent role model for all students
- To show respect to all members of the Sinhala School community
- To wear the school uniform properly to school and school functions
- To assist students, staff, school committee members and parents diligently and courteously through the duties that are associated with their role

DUTIES

- Carry out following task at the school assembly:
 - ✓ Assist the School Committee in setting up the Computers, Mics, projection screens etc.
 - ✓ Ring the Bell to start the School
 - ✓ Assist the staff to form class rows in assembly
 - ✓ Co-ordinate National Anthem and School Song during assembly
 - ✓ Ensure that children do not enter the hall whilst the national anthem & school song is sung.
 - ✓ Send students to respective classes after the assembly
- Speak representing NPSS at school events (welcome speech, vote of thanks etc.)
- Assist teachers and the committee when school is represented in community events (e.g.: BMR, New Year Celebration, Independent Day etc.)
